## CONTRACT POSITION

The Cardiac and Thoracic Surgery Unit at Flinders Medical Centre in Adelaide, South Australia is looking to fill for two locum positions:

Locum 1. Immediate start, 3 month contract

Locum 2. 29<sup>th</sup> March 2010 – 30<sup>th</sup> November 2010

Perfusion at Flinders Medical Centre is involved in over 440 open heart procedures annually, as well as supports both an active Liver Transplant Program and an ECMO (Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation) program. In addition the perfusion group is actively involved in research and teaching.

The successful applicant will receive a generous locum contract, including accommodation and relocation expenses.

Flinders Medical Centre, established in 1976, was the first medical school and teaching hospital in Australia to be planned and built as one institution. This has led to the development of a model of integrated patient care, education, research and health promotion that has received international recognition. The 580 bed public teaching hospital is situated on an 11.5 hectare campus, co-located with the Flinders University School of Medicine and the 130 bed Flinders Private Hospital.
